# Main discussion points (1)

Successful policy experimentation requires:

- very clear, well prepared and organised processes, in which all the details make a difference and play a part
- a careful and meaningful definition of the reference population according to the topic to be addressed and the intervention measure to be tested (no point to sample schools without access to technology when testing a technology-based measure, for example)
- An explicit explanation of the possible benefits from the point of view of those invited to participate (school masters and teachers) during the process (getting training, some recognition, etc.) and through the acc the findings
