<b>What you do that meet this level</b>	<p>I used both of them last year and I found out that google forms has some advantage over the edmodo app fro testing. Also its app from Apps store has a bug for handing in assignments while on android it works better.</p> <p>Overall I suggest using google forms which also has an inherent data analysis tool. I simply provide the link on edmodo which directs my students to google forms and then the carry on from there.</p> <p>My problem with online testing is that I find difficulty in delivering it to the students at certain predetermined times so that all students take the test at the same time</p>
