Type or name of ICT used	Quizlet, a mobile and web-based study application to study vocabulary or technical terms in a flash card manner
What you do that meet this level	<p>Preparing the lesson: I scan the vocabulary of the unit from the English textbook and have the text recognised by OCR software. I put the vocabulary into a table, upload it to Quizlet and copy the sharing link or send it to my students via email.</p> <p>During the lesson: I ask my students to follow the link to Quizlet on their mobile phones. The students study the new vocabulary by themselves. Towards the end of the lesson, we play Quizlet live, a collaborative classroom game.</p> <p>After the lesson: I evaluate how well the students learned the new vocabulary by checking the students' progress of those who registered with Quizlet. (Only available with a Quizlet Teacher account.)</p>
