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Title	Flipping Kahoot – Using Kahoot not as a way to test students’ knowledge, but to help students to create their own learning about a given topic in a collaborative way

What you do that meet this level	I teach in a Vocational School and students are not keen in studying no-professional subjects; they scarcely have their textbook at home! So I decided to help them in designing their learning path, fixing some topics of interest, working collaboratively to create an online quiz, to test their classmates’ knowledge – actually this is the only way they learn something: by choosing resources for the quiz and by answering their classmates quiz!
